Person Notes: Ansel crossed the plains to Oregon from Illinois with the Dimmick family in 1853 and his brother Abram. After marriage, he took up a fractional donation claim in the bend of Umpqua river 5 miles south of Elkton, where he ran one of the model farm of the district. He later took up a homestead claim and in addition to this bought sixty acres of railroad land, make his holdings aggregate almost five hundred acres.

Ansel and his brother took Donation Land Claims on the hill back of the John Peter Anderson place. The ranch buildings were located on the high ridge next to the Rapp place. It reached from river to river, the Umpqua makes a wide circle here.

He was very active, but in later years suffered much from illness. He was one of early freighters in Douglas Co. He was a veteran of the Indian Wars.

Ansel died at county hospital. Buried at George W. Dimmick's expense at Kellog Cemetary.
