Know all men by these presents that we Harloe G. Copitt & Amoret
the wife of the said Harloe of the township of Vernon County of Trumbull
& State of Ohio do covenant grant bargain sell release and confirm unto
Gideon Langdon late of the State of New York his heirs or assigns all
of the following described piece or parcel of land situated in Hartford
township, County & State aforesaid & bounded as follows, north on lands
owned by William Hull & Lewis Breakman, east on the state line, south
on the land owned by Levy Morfitt & Co & west by the center of the
Pyramalining Creek containing fifty five acres more or less for the con-
sideration of two hundred & seventy five dollars to me the said Harloe
G. Copitt in hand paid & furthermore do by these presents bind ourselves
heirs assigns or executors to warrant and defend the same from all
persons whatsoever claiming the same lawfully excepting a moiety sup-
posed to be about fifteen acres that may be claimed by the heirs of
some person now not known by us which if should ever be lawfully
claimed I am to return to the said Gideon Langdon so much of the
purchase money (if to me paid) as will make five dollars for each
acre so claimed. Given under our hands and seals the six day
